Commander's Report

With summer coming to an end and fall beginning the post will be very active with upcoming events.

First, I would like to thank Ron Moats for his dedication to the Post and accepting the role of Chairman of the Board of Directors. Your leadership and experience is greatly appreciated.

Congratulations goes out to Dave Leever, Post and District Historian, who received the Department of Maryland award for outstanding Department Pictorial Yearbook for the Post and for District 7. Great job, Dave!

Our September BBQ was a great success, with the majority of our items selling out completely. We received numerous compliments on the ribs, chicken, and pit beef. Thank you for participating and a big thank you to all our volunteers that made the event successful.

The Post will be having a Pig Roast on Sunday, October 26, 2025 in the pavilion starting at 1:00 p.m. Ralph Kenzer, along with fellow volunteers, will be preparing the pig. Guests can also enjoy fresh-cut fries, baked beans, coleslaw, and draft beer for just two dollars. The event will feature tip jars, a 50/50 raffle, and live entertainment by Kevin Booth presenting Conway Twitty all for just \$25 per person. Come out and enjoy some great BBQ and camaraderie.

We have been asked what it takes to keep our Post operating month to month? The answer is a lot of dedication and about \$100,000 in expenses. From food and beverages to payroll, gaming, and facility maintenance (including roof and HVAC repairs, inspections, equipment upkeep, and snow removal). Unfortunately, our monthly income falls short by roughly \$11,500, which is why fundraisers and our lottery account are critical to closing the gap. Another question I have been asked about is membership dues. Of the \$40 annual fee, \$23.50 goes to the National office and \$13.50 goes to the Department office leaving just \$3.00 for the Post to cover administrative costs.

We will be placing flags on veterans' graves on Saturday, November 8, 2025 and removing the flags on Saturday, November 15, 2025. If you are available to help, we will be meeting at the cemetery at 8:00 a.m. both days. Volunteers are needed for placement of the flags and removal of the flags

The annual Veterans Day program will be held at the Boonsboro High School on November 10, 2025 from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. I encourage all our veterans to attend this program to honor our men and women who have served their country.

Post 10 Honor Guard will be participating in the Sharpsburg Veteran's Day ceremony in the square at 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, November 11, 2025. Thank you to the Honor Guard in representing Post 10 all year long. Semper Fi.

Unit 10 and Squadron 10 will once again sponsor a free meal for veterans on Tuesday, November 11, 2025. Thank you to Unit 10 and Squadron 10 for their continued support of our veterans.

Post 10 will provide Christmas baskets to persons in need. Requests are due by Monday, December 15, 2025 the request forms are available at the bar. Baskets will be delivered on Saturday, December 20, 2025. Volunteers are needed to assist with the delivery of the baskets.


