The Auxiliary was busy over the past few months with Blood Drives, a craft/vendor show, Veteran's Day events, the Children's Christmas Party, providing gift cards for the North Point Vets, and participating in numerous other Post functions. In addition, we made donations to the following: VA Hospital and Women's Boutique in Martinsburg, the Walter Reed Christmas party, Crop Walk, Breast Cancer Society, Head Start, Wreaths Across America, and several local school & community events.

The Craft/Vendor show held in early Nov. was very successful, tables were sold out. We are planning another one in early Nov. 2026. Watch for future announcements for this event. The annual Children's Christmas Party took place at the Post on December 7. Santa met with each child and gave them a gift, distributing nearly 100 presents in total. All essays must be submitted by February 1, and winners will be recognized during our April 2026 meeting. Parents seeking further information about contest guidelines and required forms are encouraged to contact their child's school.

The Unit will be sponsoring one or more scholarships this year to a graduating high school senior from Boonsboro High School including Tech High and Barbara Ingram School for the Arts. Eligibility requires one of the applicants' parents, grandparents, or guardian to be a member of Clopper Michael Post 10, Auxiliary Unit 10, or SAL Squadron 10 consecutively for the past two (2) years. The candidate must request and return an application and appropriate forms to Unit 10 chairperson Cindy Kauffman, by Apr. 15, 2026. Mrs. Kauffman's phone number is 301-432-6254. Applications will be available at the Post or at the high school around mid-January. Check with the High School for additional information.

- 3) All operators must be properly licensed and insured per state laws.
- 4) Cannot be a member of another ALR group.
- 5) Pay \$15 dues.

If you don't own a motorcycle, the Chapter also welcomes supporting, non-voting members and junior members. The essential requirements mirror numbers 1, 4 and 5 above.
